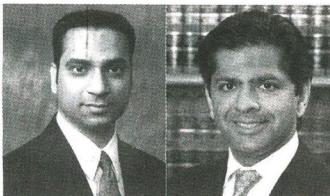


LI Lawyer Ones to Watch
